Commissioners, back in June, specifically June 14th, you approved an allocation for our Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program Employment and Training allocation for 2019 that totaled 11,978,170. Since that time, we've become aware of and good news, additional funding that's available to the State of Texas for this

1 program, exactly one million more funding in fact. So, this  
2 morning, staff is recommending for your consideration and  
3 possible approval, to modify the allocation for fiscal year  
4 2019 for the SNAP E&T program to 12,978,170. And in  
5 addition, staff is also recommending with that change, that  
6 that would also affect the small board funding for the SNAP  
7 E&T program slightly. And in the second page of your  
8 document, we highlight that as well. The staff would also  
9 recommend making that modification, consistent with the  
10 methodology that's followed for that small board funding.

11 Unless you have questions, Commissioners,  
12 that would be the recommendation of staff.
