




### **History of Texas Rising Star**



- In September 2022, the Commission adopted amendments to TWC Chapter 809 Child Care Services rules to implement the new requirements. Effective October 3, 2022, all CCS child care and early learning programs must participate in the Texas Rising Star program. In order to be a CCS provider, child care and early learning programs must:
  - meet the Entry- Level designation point threshold; and
  - attain at least a Two-Star certification level within 24 months






- Have an active agreement with a Board to accept referrals from the TWC Child Care Services program and a current Entry Level Designation
- Licensed Child Care Center/ Licensed Child Care Home/ Registered Child Care Home
- Have a permanent (non-expiring) license or registration from Child Care Regulations (CCR)
- Have at least 12 months of licensing history with CCR
- Demostrate a high level of compliance with CCR minimum standards over the preceding 12 months in accordance with the TDC Initial Companies Form


