

- Classroom Assessment Record Form
 - Retain P-GSSR-01 and -02; P-WRS-01 through -06; P-LFS-01 through -10; P-PBIG-01 through -04; & P-SCR-01 through -08
 - Remove (N/A) P-IFAL-01 through -05
 - Retain Indoor environment measures
 - Remove (N/A) Outdoor measures (per CCR program is not required to provide outdoor play if less than 5 hours served)
- Require to visit a program that offers full-time care (during summer or holidays) when that care
 is being provided vs part-time care

 - Remove P-FI-02 Parent Conferences, P-PM-02 Health/Nutrition, & P-PM-03 and -04 Curriculum /Supports
- Classroom Assessment Record Form
 - Retain P-GSSR-01 and -02; P-WRS-01 through -06; P-LFS-01 through -10; P-PBIG-01 through -04; & P-SCR-01 through -08
 - Remove (N/A) P-IFAL-01 through -05
 - Retain Indoor environment measures
 - Remove (N/A) Outdoor measures if overnight care only (remains if offers weekend care)
- Require to visit a program that offers weekend care when that care is being provided
- Require to visit a program at least 2 hours prior to "bedtime" for overnight care only

- □ Initial Screening Form process
- Certified (Probation B process and added deficiency (ratios) and revised deficiency (director responsibilities))
- □ Reinstatement after impact process (Rule Change)
- Automated screening process
- □ Category 1: Director/Staff Qualifications/Training
 - □ Split Training Measures, Defined School-Age Director, and Revised allowable qualifications
 - □ Added WF Registry participation points-based measure

Category 2: Interactions

- □ Revised scoring criteria for consistency & measures for clarification and removed a duplicative measure
- □ NEW measure related to classrooms utilizing child assessment tools

Category 3: Program Administration

- □ Revised 3 measures for clarification and changes to School-Age Only
- □ NEW measure related to required developmental screenings (0-5 years)
- Revised Parent Policy measure to omit duplication and added developmental screening and early intervention support, as well as condensing challenging behaviors
- □ Removed 3 measures: Challenging behaviors (condensed into Parent Policy) and 2 Child Assessment
- Category 4: Learning Environments
 - Revised 2 measures for clarification

Facility Change Process: retaining certification with initial permit (up to 6 months); assessment within 3-months
