1 **Texas Prekindergarten Partnership Summit** 2 **Discussion Paper** 3 **Background** 4 The Texas Workforce Commission's (TWC) Child Care and Early Learning department is 5 working with the Texas Education Agency (TEA) on the implementation of the prekindergarten 6 (pre-K) provisions contained in House Bill (HB) 3, 86th Texas Legislature, Regular Session 7 (2019). TEA has posted information on its website about legislative changes to establish full-day 8 pre-K for eligible four-year-old children.¹ 9 HB 3 allows for lead education agencies (LEAs) to offer pre-K services through public-private 10 partnerships.² Pre-K services may be offered through Texas Rising Star (TRS) 3- or 4-Star 11 Program providers. To facilitate the development of public-private partnerships, TWC and TEA are discussing training and coordination opportunities and have identified an opportunity to 12 13 leverage an event that Children at Risk and the United Way of Texas are developing. **Issue**

15 Children at Risk and the United Way of Texas are seeking foundation funding to support a Texas

- 16 Prekindergarten Partnership Summit in the spring of 2020. The summit will be held in Houston
- 17 and will be an opportunity for Local Workforce Development Boards (Boards) and LEAs to
- 18 meet, learn about pre-K partnership models that can support public-private pre-K classrooms,
- 19 and collaborate on opportunities to develop models locally.

TWC funding would support the cost of Boards' attendance. Travel amounts for each Board will vary based on the number attending and distance from the event.

Decision Point

25 Staff seeks direction on providing approximately \$65,000 in funding to Boards to support their 26 attendance at the Texas Prekindergarten Partnership Summit, scheduled to take place in the 27 spring of 2020. Attendance would include four staff members from large Boards, three staff

28 members from medium Boards, and two staff members from small Boards (Attachment 1).

29 Additionally, funds would support attendance of one TRS 3- or 4- Star Program provider from 30 each Board's local workforce development area.

The amount for each Board would be finalized following the summit, based on actual travel costs. Boards will be required to submit final travel costs to TWC, and TWC will increase each Board's Child Care Quality contract accordingly.

Texas Prekindergarten Partnership Summit—Board Classifications and Reimbursement **Parameters**

Boards will be required to find the most cost-efficient travel alternatives to the Texas Prekindergarten Partnership Summit. Boards within three hours driving distance will be reimbursed for the cost of a rental car, hotel, and per diem (based on actual, up-to-the-maximum per diem rate). Boards farther than three hours driving distance will be reimbursed for the most economical airfare, the cost of a rental car, hotel, and per diem (based on actual, up-to-themaximum per diem rate). Large Boards will be reimbursed no more than \$3,600; medium Boards will be reimbursed no more than \$2,900; and small Boards will be reimbursed no more than \$2,300.
