- 4 Texas Labor Code §315.005 and Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) Chapter 805 Adult
- 5 Education and Literacy rule §805.43 require TWC to establish an Adult Education and Literacy
- 6 (AEL) advisory committee. Texas Labor Code requires the committee to meet at least quarterly,
- 7 report annually to TWC's three-member Commission (Commission), and advise the Commission
- 8 on various policies related to adult education in the state. The advisory committee must:
- not be composed of more than nine members;
 - include at least one representative of the business community; and
- include at least one representative of a Local Workforce Development Board (Board).
- Members serve two-year terms and may be reappointed to a second term by the Commission.
- 13 Issue
- 14 There are currently nine (9) committee members, as shown in Table 1, with three (3) vacancies
- opening in May 2025. Table 2 lists nominees to fill these vacancies.
