5	The Adult Education and Literacy (AEL) Health Care Initiative for Internationally Trained
6	Professionals (ITPs) Request for Applications (RFA) sought grantees to develop and disseminate
7	effective models that expand Texas' ability to provide quality career pathway services for ELLs
8	who are ITPs with healthcare-related degrees. By building the infrastructure to create re-
9	employment pathways for these skilled professionals, Texas can increase its productivity,
0	household earnings, and tax contributions.

2	Issue
3	The CPPDC RFA evaluation team reviewed ten eligible applications. The anticipated grant start
4	is June 2025, and one winner is recommended for a total award of \$500,000.
5	
6	Decision Point
7	Staff recommends approval of the above award for the AEL Healthcare Initiative for ITPs,
8	totaling \$500,000.
