## TxUS Tax is coming in 2026!

In early 2026, TWC is transitioning to a new consolidated Texas Unemployment Insurance (UI) System, TxUS.

TxUS replaces existing tax systems and public facing web applications including the UI Tax Registration (UTR), UI Tax Services (UTS), QuickFile, and Magnetic Media.

TxUS makes unemployment tax management easier for Texas employers and agents.

## TxUS Wage Reporting is Easier:

Employers will be able to submit quarterly reports with ease and amend wage data through convenient online amendments in TxUS.

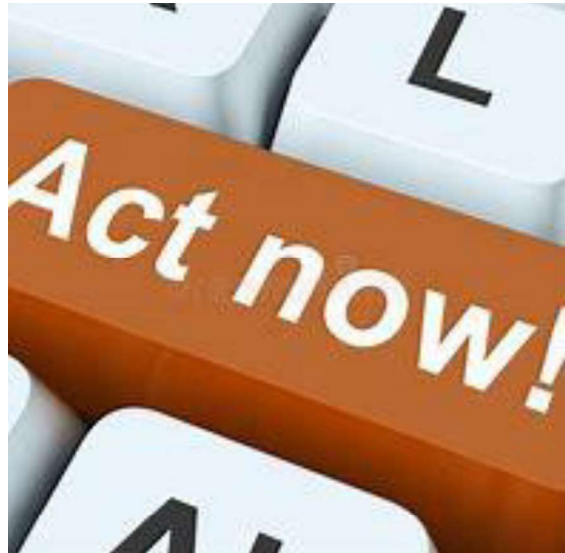
Along with a new and modern look, TxUS makes things easier for employers and agents with the following:

- **Log in to your Unemployment Tax Services account:** UTS Log On

  - Phone number
  - Payroll address



## Credentialing

A new authentication process will be implemented when TxUS goes live in 2026. You will need to create a new user ID, password, and security questions within the TxUS system.

This applies to all users including employers, third party administrators (TPAs), and service agents.

## Frequently Asked Questions

### **Will my current User ID and password transfer to the new system?**

No, you will need to create a new user profile, password, and security questions when you first log in to TxUS. More details to follow. Each user ID must be associated with a unique email address.

### **Will my TWC account number change?**

No, your TWC account number will remain the same.

### **Is QuickBooks going away?**

Intuit, the owner of QuickBooks, will no longer have streamlined access for submitting tax reports to TWC. Intuit (and all the other service agents) will use the method for submitting reports through TxUS.
