

New TxUS Go-Live Date

The new Texas Unemployment System (TxUS) for tax will go live by or on June 1, 2026. Each month, we will provide updates and information about the new system to help you prepare for the transition.

Functionality Spotlight

TxUS will replace the current Unemployment Tax Services (UTS) and Unemployment Tax Registration (UTR) applications. The new landing page allows employers and agents to access their own separate portal.



At a Glance

Employer Dashboard

Establishing Credentials

Employers and third-party agents are required to create a new user ID and password to access the new TxUS application. Each user ID requires a unique email address. Stay tuned for more details.

Did You Know?

Employers will be able to request waivers (abatements) and refunds directly from the new TxUS application. Third-party agents can request these if they have been granted the proper permissions from the employers they represent. No more waiting in line to submit a request!
