
Our **MISSION** is to improve the well-being of those we serve with a **commitment to excellence**: every patient, every encounter, every time.



#### Our Innovative Solution: The RN Apprenticeship Program

- · First of its kind in Texas approved by U.S. Department of Labor
- Joint approval with Texas Board of Nursing
- Designed to:
  - Onboard apprentices into paid, structured training
  - Blend classroom learning + clinical rotations + mentorship
  - Transition graduates directly into RN roles



#### Rio Grande Valley College Registered Nurse Apprenticeship Program - Key Milestones

August 2023 - Approved by U.S. Department of Labor (applies to both programs)

April 2024 - Approved by the Texas Board of Nursing

October 2024 - Onboarded 2nd Cohort of RN Apprentices

**January 2025 -** Onboarded 3rd Cohort of RN Apprentices

May 2025 - Graduated 1st Cohort / Onboarded 4th Cohort

September 2025 - Graduated 2nd Cohort / Onboarded 5th Cohort











#### South Texas College Registered Nurse Apprenticeship Program - Key Milestones

**July 2024 -** Approved by Texas Board of Nursing

**January 2025 -** Onboarded 1st Cohort of RN Apprentices

March 2025 - Apprentices completed onboarding and began clinical floor rotations

April 2025 - DHR Health and STC held Apprenticeship Committee Meeting

**September 2025 -** Onboarded 2nd Cohort of RN Apprentices









# RN Apprenticeship Program Results Rio Grande Valley College

#### **Cohort 1 - Graduated May 2025**

- 12 Nurse Apprentices graduated
- 10 hired into full-time RN roles at DHR Health
- Serving across acute and post-acute settings

#### **Cohort 2 - Graduated September 2025**

- 14 Nurse Apprentices graduated
- 12 hired into full-time RN roles at DHR Health
- Serving across acute and post-acute settings
