IRS Form 8850 Required Values

"Application is untimely filed" - Application is over one year old.

Schedule

- Column A
 - "Column A must be 9 digits in TEXT format for leading zeros."
- Column B
 - o "Column B must be 9 digits in TEXT format for leading zeros."
 - o "The EIN is required."
 - "The EIN entered is invalid."
 - "No ERD/POA is on file for the CEIN/EIN combo."
 - The ERD on file has expired; or
 - there is no ERD on file.
- Column C
 - "Column C must be 9 digits in TEXT format for leading zeros."
 - "Applicant SSN is required."
 - "The SSN entered is invalid."
 - "Duplicate submission based on SSN, EIN, and Start Date"
- Column D
 - o "The Date of Birth cannot occur after today."
 - "The Date of Birth must be in YYYYMMDD format."
- Column E
 - "The Hired Date cannot occur after today."
 - "The Hire Date must be in YYYYMMDD format."
 - "The Hire Date is required."
 - "HIRED Date must be EQUAL TO or BEFORE the Start Date."
- Column F
 - "The Start Date cannot occur after today."
 - "The Start Date must be in YYYYMMDD format."
 - "The Start Date is required."
 - "START Date must be EQUAL to or AFTER the Hired Date."
- Column G
 - "Applicant's Last Name is required."
- Column H
 - "Applicant's First Name is required."
- Column I
 - "Applicant's Address is required."
- Column J
 - "Applicant's City is required."

- Column K
 - "Applicant's State is required."
 - Possible Error "State given is not an acceptable state abbreviation."
- Column L
 - "Applicant's Zip is required."

Note: ZIP Code **must** be in Text format for leading zeros.

IRS Form 8850 Questions 1-7 - Values are NOT required to be entered unless a specific TG is requested.

- Column O
 - o Q1 cannot be a value other than Y, N or left blank
- Column P
 - o Q2 cannot be a value other than Y, N, or left blank
- Column Q
 - Q3 cannot be a value other than Y, N, or left blank
- Column R
 - Q4 cannot be a value other than Y, N, or left blank
- Column S
 - o Q5 cannot be a value other than Y, N, or left blank
- Column T
 - Q6 cannot be a value other than Y, N, or left blank
- Column U
 - o Q7 cannot be a value other than Y, N, or left blank

ETA Form 9061 Questions - Values are NOT required to be entered unless a specific TG is requested.

- Column V
 - Qualified IVA cannot be a value other than Y, N, or left blank
- Column W
 - Qualified IVA State Enter two-digit state abbreviation if benefits were received outside of Texas.
 - Possible error Qualified IVA State given is not an acceptable state abbreviation.

 - Qualified Vet cannot be a value other than Y, N, or left blank
- Column Y
