For over 25 years, the Skills Development Fund grant program has assisted more than 5,000 private employers by financing the design and implementation of customized job-training projects. This fund successfully merges business needs and local, customized training opportunities into a winning formula to increase the skills, levels and wages of the Texas workforce.

Texas Workforce Commission connects businesses, colleges, and local workforce boards to facilitate project development and the grant application process. Customized training programs can include classroom, simulation, on-site, hands-on or online instruction. For each Skills Development Fund grant, TWC awards up to \$500,000 and can cover tuition, curriculum development, instructor fees, and materials.

Who Is Eligible to Apply?

Public community colleges, technical colleges, workforce boards, Texas A&M Extension Services (TEEX), or the Texas A&M Engineering Experiment Station (TEES) may apply.

Who Can Be Trained?

Most full time, W-2 paid employees who meet the prevailing wage threshold are eligible to participate.

Invest in Your Employees

The 12-month grant term is available with no application window. It has only a six-month waiting period on year-over-year re-application.
