**Subject: Contract Amendment Process for Adult Education and Literacy and English Literacy and Civics Grantee Contracts Ending August 31, 2014**

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**PURPOSE:**

To provide Adult Education and Literacy (AEL) Fiscal Agents and English Literacy and Civics Grantees<sup>1</sup> with information and guidance on the process for requesting budget adjustments and budget amendments for AEL contracts ending August 31, 2014.

**BACKGROUND:**

Texas Labor Code, Chapter 315, transferred the AEL program from the Texas Education Agency to the Texas Workforce Commission on September 1, 2013.

**PROCEDURES:**

**Budget Adjustments**

AEL entities must be aware that budget adjustments:

- are requests to move funds between cost categories, which:
  - reduce a cost category by 20% or less; or
  - total \$50,000 or less for all changes; and
- require a recommendation by the contract manager and approval by the director of Board and Special Initiative Contracts.

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**Budget Amendments**

AEL entities must be aware that budget amendments:

- are requests to move funds between cost categories, which:
  - reduce a cost category by 20% or more; or
  - total \$50,000 or more for all changes; and

- will be approved by the director of Workforce Development Division within 14 days of receipt.

**Submission of Budget Adjustments and Budget Amendments**

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For all budget adjustments or budget amendments, AEL entities must submit the appropriate Schedule #6—Program Budget Summary, included as attachments to this AEL Letter, to [bcm@twc.texas.gov](mailto:bcm@twc.texas.gov) by the following deadlines:

- Budget adjustment requests—8/15/2014
- Budget amendment requests—7/15/2014
