Finding Qualified Workers

After speaking with thousands of employers from all over the state and from all professions and walks of life, it is clear that the single most pressing concern they all share is their difficulty finding qualified employees. Good employees are your best asset, and recruiting, training and retaining them are all critical to the well being and growth of your business.

You or your staff can contact a local Workforce Solutions Office to place job orders for skilled or unskilled workers. Trained Workforce Development Specialists use an automated job matching system to search for qualified workers to fill your job openings. Employers can indicate to what degree they want to “advertise” or expose their job opening(s) to job seekers and the general public, with or without intervention of Workforce Solutions Office staff.

The Texas Workforce Network also offers a unique Internet job matching service that can be accessed by employers who wish to enter their own job orders and search a database of more than 1.4 million job applicants, without assistance from Workforce Development staff.
