### **BACKGROUND:**

On June 14, 2018, the Texas Workforce Commission's three-member Commission approved FY'18 supplemental child care allocations. The approved allocations are available under Annual Allocations at <http://www.twc.state.tx.us/agency/texas-workforce-commission-financial-grant-information>.
