

Extended Unemployment Benefits in Texas

If you are eligible for a benefit extension after you exhaust your regular unemployment benefits, TWC will mail (and email you if we have your email address) information about the additional benefits you may receive. Make sure TWC has your current address and email address.

Regular Unemployment Benefits (REG) Extended Benefits (EB)

Regular (REG) Up to 26 Weeks

- Eligibility rules (past wages, qualifying separation) apply

Apply for Benefits at ui.texasworkforce.org

Extended Benefits (EB) Up to 13 weeks or 50% of Maximum Benefit Amount, whichever is less

- Must have exhausted regular UI benefits
- Only available when the 12-week Insured Unemployment Rate (IUR) is 5% or more.
- Texas qualified for EB on May 31, 2020
