Laws Enacted during the 88th Legislature.

House Bill 567 stops employers from unfairly treating people applying for a job. Or workers based on their hair texture or style of their hair. It is illegal for an employer to unfairly treat a person because of their hair texture or hairdo.

House Bill 567 protects renters and homeowners from unfair treatment. Hairstyles such as braids, locks, and twists are protective hairstyles. House bill 1193 protects renters from property owners who unfairly treat renters because of their method to pay.

These bills became law on September 1, 2023.
