Subject: BCY 21 Child Care Local Match Agreements

Date: February 2, 2021 Commission Meeting

Issue: Acceptance of BCY 21 Child Care Local Match Agreements from Boards

Facts:

Annually, local workforce development boards submit local match pledges to secure federal child care funds pursuant to Commission rule §809.17. This will be a standing agenda item, as Boards may continue to submit match agreements through January 31, 2021.

## Staff requests Commission acceptance of child care pledges for donations, transfers, and certifications of expense for BCY 21 in the amount of \$5,760,100.

Today's summary includes twenty-six (26) match agreements from thirteen (13) Boards, which includes Borderplex, Cameron County, Concho Valley, Dallas County, Heart of Texas, Lower Rio Grande Valley, Middle Rio Grande Valley, Northeast, North Central, North Texas, Panhandle, South Plains and West Central.

Twenty-seven (27) boards have secured a portion of match with twenty-two (22) securing at least 50% of the total. Of the twenty-two (22), sixteen (16) have secured match, of which five (5) have exceeded their BCY 21 match target.

Boards have secured 86.80% of the statewide child care local match target compared to 81.41% at this time last year (01/21/2020).

All Boards with no match have been contacted to determine status, and all have indicated agreements coming soon. Only one Board has not submitted an agreement, however they are working on their submission.

Due to an pledge increase of over \$100,000 from the City of Abilene, not only did West Central secure its match; the Board also exceeded its local match target by over \$433,000.
