Second Chance Event 1 2 **Discussion Paper** 3 **Background** 4 5 On December 1, 2020, the Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) accepted a private one-time donation 6 from IKEA US Community Foundation to support a variety of TWC initiatives to help Texans and Texas 7 businesses impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. 8 On August 31, 2021, Commissioner Julian Alvarez stated before the Commission that he would like staff 9 to explore utilizing the remaining IKEA funds to host a second chance roundtable event and invite 10 employers, economic development corporations and training providers. The purpose of this event will 11 be to provide information to employers about the value of hiring second chance individuals to fill gaps in 12 their workforce caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. 13 Issue 14 Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, employers have continued to struggle with filling their vacant positions. 15 The second chance community is an accessible group of capable individuals that can fill these vacant 16 positions. However, employers need to be aware of the support and services available to them in regard 17 to hiring individuals within the second chance community. 18 The event proposed by Commissioner Alvarez will provide information to employers about TWC 19 programs such as fidelity bonding, the Work Opportunity Tax Credit, Adult Education and Literacy, and 20 Registered Apprenticeships. The event will highlight TWC grant opportunities and showcase examples 21 of collaboration to assist the second chance population across the state of Texas as well. TWC will also 22 collaborate with organizations such as statewide business associations, chambers, and economic 23 development organizations to enhance the reach of the event. 24 Staff anticipate this event will involve costs for the following: 25 Venue 26 Promotional/Outreach Materials 27 **Light Refreshments Decision Point** 28
