## Board Contract Year 2022 Child Care Local Match <br> Discussion Paper

## Background

The Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) allocates federal funding for child care services from the Child Care and Development Fund (CCDF) to local workforce development areas (workforce areas). For a portion of the CCDF funding, Local Workforce Development Boards (Boards) are required to secure and submit local matching funds to TWC in accordance with federal regulations and TWC Chapter 809 Child Care Services rules and TWC Chapter 800 General Administration rules.

## Issue

Boards submit annual local match pledges from private and public entities to secure federal child care funds pursuant to $\S \underline{809.17}$ and to maximize resources for child care needs in the community.

Supporting documents include fifteen (15) Board Contract Year 2022 (BCY'22) match agreements from six (6) Boards (Borderplex, Central Texas, Dallas County, Gulf Coast, Lower Rio, and North Texas).

Boards have secured 8.03 percent of the statewide child care local match target for BCY' 22 with one (1) Board securing at least 50 percent of their target.

## Decision Point

Staff seeks direction on accepting child care pledges for donations, transfers, and certifications of expense for BCY 22 in the amount of $\$ 3,319,041$.
