15	Texas Labor Code, §302.00341(b) requires the Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) to "develop and
16 17	administer a program under which the commission may award grants to one or more nonprofit organizations that facilitate the participation in apprenticeship training programs of veterans and active
18	duty military service members who are transitioning into civilian employment."
19	
20	Texas Labor Code, §302.00341(c) stipulates that a grant awarded under Texas Labor Code, §302.00341,
21	may only be used to recruit or assist veterans or transitioning service members.
22	
23	Texas Labor Code, §302.00341(d) requires TWC to adopt rules to administer this grant. The rules must
24	include a process to verify that state funds awarded to a nonprofit organization under Texas Labor Code,
25	§302.00341 are used appropriately.
26	
27	Purpose for the Proposed Rule
28	The purpose of this rulemaking is to establish the Veterans Apprenticeship Training Grant Program to
29	implement SB 337.
30	
31	New Rules Required by Federal Regulation or State Statute
32	
33	Issue #1: Implementation of SB 337
34	SB 337 added Texas Labor Code, §302.00341, which allows TWC to develop and administer a program
35	to provide grants to one or more nonprofit organizations to facilitate a veteran's or transitioning military
36	service member's participation in registered apprenticeship programs. A grant provided under this
37	program shall be used for recruitment or assistance provided to such veterans or transitioning service
38	members. TWC will need to develop a process to verify the grant is used for the intended purpose.
