9 10	 will provide professional development to tutors, instructors, administrative staff, and trainers of Non-Profit Adult Literacy Organizations in Texas.
11	TWC recognizes the importance of building capacity for non-profit community and volunteer-
12	based literacy providers to serve AEL students and the value these entities offer as part of the
13 14	Texas Workforce Solutions AEL provider network. This RFA sought professional development and services integration of these valued providers within AEL and underscores TWC's
15	commitment to support the expansion and capacity building of non-profits and volunteer-based
16	services.
17	Texas Labor Code states in section 315.007(d) "the members of the commission [must]
18 19	approve the award of any funds under this chapter."
20	Issue
21	The anticipated grant start date is August 2022, and 1 winner has been recommended for a total
22	award of \$300,000. This is the full amount allocated to this initiative, as proposed on July 7th,
23	2021.
24	The following award, totaling \$300,000, awaits the approval of the Texas Workforce
25	Commission's three-member Commission (Commission):
