3	Background		
4	Senate Bill 0001, Article VII, Rider 46, of the 87th Texas Legislature (Regular Session) requires		
5	that the Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) explicitly permit the use of digital skill building		
6	in all workforce programs. Additionally, Adult Education and Literacy (AEL) state leadership		
7	funds provided under the Adult Education and Family Literacy Act (AEFLA), as outlined in		
8	§223 of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA), must be used to develop or		
9	enhance the AEL program as prescribed by AEFLA. WIOA §223 state leadership activities are		
10	designated as either required or permissible activities.		
11	Issue: Content Standards Enhancement with Digital Literacy Competencies ¹ —\$200,000		
12	TWC's three-member Commission (Commission) may identify projects to enhance the AEL		
13	system using state leadership funds. TWC staff has identified an opportunity to respond to Rider		
14	46 with an enhancement to the AEL Content Standards (Standards 4.0) that aligns digital literacy		
15	competencies with each of the benchmarks in the AEL Content Standards. The Commission has		
16	previously funded enhancements to the AEL Content Standards, originally published in 2016, as		
17	follows:		
18	• The Standards 2.0, published in 2018, aligned AEL competencies with the knowledge,		
19	skills, and abilities required for success in in-demand entry- and intermediate-level jobs		
20	in four industry clusters.		
21	• The Standards 3.0, published in 2021, added family literacy and civics education		
22	benchmarks.		
23	Furthermore, staff has identified an opportunity to amend the existing statewide professional		
24	development contract for distance education, the Distance Education Professional Development		
25	Center (DEPDC). The amendment will add \$200,000 for the development of Digital Literacy		
26	Content Standards and professional development training offered through the DEPDC to		
27	educators and workforce development specialists.		
28	Decision Point		
29	Staff seeks direction on amending the DEPDC contract (2921AEL004) to add \$200,000 with		
30	Fiscal Year 2023 (FY'23) Budget of AEL state leadership funds to both enhance the AEL		
31	Content Standards with digital literacy competencies and provide training to instructors on use of		

32 these standards.
