Child Care & Development Block Grant (CCDBG) COVID-19 Federal Funding 6th Tranche of New Initiatives - Modification Discussion Paper

1 Background

- 2 On March 8, 2022 the Texas Workforce Commission's (TWC) three-member Commission (Commission)
- 3 approved the <u>Sixth Tranche</u> of child care stimulus funded initiatives, which including funding for the
- 4 Provider Cost of Quality Calculator (PCQC)'s online, web-based, interactive tool. The PCQC website's
- 5 cost was estimated at \$800,000 (with ongoing annual updates to the data, to be approved through TWC's
- 6 Annual Operating Budget, estimated at \$125,000/year).
- 7 The PCQC will support a narrow cost analysis that examines the cost of child care at varying levels of
- 8 quality across the state. CCDBG requires states to conduct a narrow cost analysis and to consider the data
- 9 in rate-setting. In addition to serving as a tool for a narrow cost analysis, a PCQC can also be beneficial
- 10 to child care providers and other stakeholders to help identify gaps between the cost of providing quality
- services and the revenue available. This information can help inform the design of local quality
- improvement efforts, and it can help providers better understand the factors that influence costs.

13 Issue

- 14 To efficiently deliver the PCQC, TWC leveraged a Department of Information Resources statewide
- 15 contract. Through the process of defining the project scope and obtaining the vendor quote, however, staff
- have additional funding is needed, due to higher than anticipated information technology costs. An
- additional \$400,000 will support the development and deployment of the tool, bringing the initiative total
- to \$1.2 million. As a public-facing tool for child care providers, the PCQC will be placed on the new
- 19 provider portal being developed under the Child Care Case Management system.

20 **Decision Point**

- 21 Staff recommends dedicating approximately \$400,000 in additional child care stimulus funding to the
- 22 PCQC initiative to fund the work under a statewide cooperative contract as described above.
