



**MEETING OF THE
TEXAS WORKFORCE COMMISSION**

1 Tuesday, January 10, 2023

2 CHAIRMAN DANIEL: Good morning, everyone.

3 This meeting is called to order. Mr. Trobman, has anyone signed
4 up for public comment?

5 MR. TROBMAN: No, sir.

6 CHAIRMAN DANIEL: Thank you, Mr. Trobman.

7 This is Agenda Item 3, Evaluation of the Child Care
8 Effectiveness Report. Good morning.

9 ALLISON WILSON: Good morning. For the
10 record, Allison Wilson with the Child Care & Early Learning
11 Division. Texas Labor Code requires that TWC evaluate the
12 effectiveness of the commission's child care program. TWC must
13 report the results of the evaluation to the legislature no later
14 than January 15th of each odd-numbered year. The report includes
15 information on employment and wage outcomes for parents who
16 receive subsidized child care, the reach and impact of the Texas
17 Rising Star program, and collaborative interagency efforts to
18 improve child care and early learning across Texas. I also want
19 to highlight that while this report is only required once every
20 two years, in 2019, we started making much of the data available
21 publicly on an ongoing basis. We publish this information on
22 TWC's Child Care by The Numbers website and update it quarterly.
23 We also continue to regularly roll out enhancements and new
24 datapoints that are responsive to our stakeholders' needs. Staff
25 recommends approving this report for submission to the

1 legislature and authorizing staff to make any nonsubstantive
2 changes needed prior to submission. That concludes my remarks.
3 Happy to answer any questions.

4 CHAIRMAN DANIEL: All right. Thank you.
5 Comments?

6 COMMISSIONER DEMERSON: No comments or
7 questions.

8 CHAIRMAN DANIEL: No comments or questions.
9 Is there a motion?

10 COMMISSIONER DEMERSON: Chairman, I move
11 that we approve the report evaluating the effectiveness of the
12 child care program for fiscal years 2021 through 2022 for
13 submission to the 88th Texas Legislature as recommended today by
14 staff.

16 We're unanimous. Thank you.

17 ALLISON WILSON: Thank you.

18 CHAIRMAN DANIEL: This is Agenda Item 6,
19 Board Nominations.

20 CHERIE DUDLEY: Good morning, chairman,
21 commissioner, Mr. Townsend. Happy New Year to everyone. For the
22 record, Cherie Dudley with Workforce Development. Today for your
23 consideration we have Workforce Board nominations for Concho
24 Valley, Northeast Texas, West Central Texas, and South Plains.

1 Staff recommends approval on the presented nominees and I'm here
2 to answer any questions you may have.

3 CHAIRMAN DANIEL: Thank you very much. Any
4 comments or questions?

5 COMMISSIONER DEMERSON: None here.

6 CHAIRMAN DANIEL: Is there a motion?

7 COMMISSIONER DEMERSON: This motion, I move
8 that we approve the local Workforce Development board member
9 nominees presented today for the following: Workforce Solutions
10 Concho Valley, Northeast Texas, West Central Texas, and South

14 CHERIE DUDLEY: Thank you.
