

MEETING OF THE TEXAS WORKFORCE COMMISSION

CHAIRMAN DANIEL: Good afternoon, all. This meeting is called to order, and happy new year. Mr. Trobman, has anyone signed up for public comment?

CHAIRMAN DANIEL: Thank you much. Good afternoon, Ms. Miller. A rare afternoon meeting, how about that?

MS. MILLER: Yes, sir. Good afternoon.

CHAIRMAN DANIEL: Thank you very much. This brings us to the end of Agenda Items 1 through 8. We'll take a short recess.

CHAIRMAN DANIEL: All right, we're back with Agenda Item 9, statewide agencies new hire report.

BRYAN SNODDY: Good afternoon, Chair Daniel, commissioners, Mr. Serna. Thank you for your time today for taking under consideration, discussion, consideration, and possible action, the submission of the fiscal year 2023 Texas Workforce Commission new hire summary report to the governor and the Legislative Budget Board pursuant to Texas Labor Code, Section 21.504. Pursuant to the statute we have compiled a report of the total number of African Americans, Hispanics, females, and other persons hired for each job category by all state agencies during the preceding state fiscal year. We note that this is a new procedure and bringing this report separate from the annual TWC report where it's historically been combined. This disaggregation should unburden the agency annual

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   report from all future [inaudible] 21 statutory deadlines. Staff
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   has compiled information in a compressed format that aid
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   comprehension and utility and in general this report
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   demonstrates the good work the state agencies are doing to hire
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   in each job category and maintain an engaged workforce for the
   state of Texas. Today staff makes recommendation to adopt this
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   report for submission to the governor and Legislative Budget
   Board in satisfaction of Section 21.504 of the Texas Labor Code.

CHAIRMAN DANIEL: It's been moved and seconded and the vote is unanimous and the motion carries. This is Agenda Item 11, child care match.

SANDRA WILLIAMS: Good afternoon, commissioners, Mr. Serna. For the record, Sandra Williams, Workforce Development Division. In accordance with federal regulations and TWC Chapter 809, Child Care Services rules, TWC does require boards to secure and submit local matching funds to TWC in order to receive a portion of the CCDF funding.

Supporting documentation includes 45 BCY24 match agreements from 13 boards. Those boards are Borderplex, Cameron County, Concho Valley, East Texas, Gulf Coast, Lower Rio, North Central Texas, Northeast Texas, Panhandle, Permian Basin, South Plains, Tarrant County, and West Central Texas totaling \$14,014,217. Boards have secured 66.28 percent of the statewide child care local match target for BCY24 with six of those 13 boards securing at least 100 percent of their target. Staff is recommending that TWC accept child care pledges for donations, transfers, and

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   certifications for expenses for BCY24 in the amount of
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   $14,014,217. I'm happy to answer any questions.
