We help Texans with disabilities discover meaningful careers. Whether you want to find employment, advance in your current career, or prepare for a new career – we are here to help.



Services are designed for you based on your individual needs, interests and goals. These services, provided by teams of dedicated and highly trained counselors, change the lives of thousands of Texans with disabilities.

Services can include

- Tuition assistance that leads to a career;
 - Specialized training and adaptive equipment to help address a barrier to employment;
 - Vehicle modification to travel to and from work independently; and
 - Therapies and services to reduce the impact a disability may have on achieving your employment goal.

Find a Meaningful Career

We focus on your needs, career interests, abilities and employment goal to help you find a job that fits you.

Advance in Your Career

Receive help with accommodations at your current job so you can focus on growing your skills.

Find a New Career

Receive training or help with transferring your skills to a new career that showcases your abilities.

What types of disabilities are included?

If it's been difficult for you to find a job or be successful on the job due to a physical or mental disability, VR Services may be able to help you. Your counselor will help determine your eligibility for services. A few examples of the types of disabilities we support are:

- Mental health condition
- Physical disability
- Hearing loss/deafness
- · Chronic health condition
- · Substance use disorder
- · Learning disability
- · Low vision or blindness







Your Journey to Employment

Your vocational rehabilitation counselor will stand by you throughout your journey, whether it be short- or long-term. The team effort continues for 90-days after your employment to ensure your employment success.



Step 1:

Assess your interests

Your counselor can recommend career and disability assessments to determine your interests, skills and needs.

Step 2:

Create your employment plan

Identify your employment goals and write a step-by-step plan together with your counselor to ensure you can achieve it.

We're Here To Help!

Who can benefit from VR Services?

You can benefit from Vocational Rehabilitation Services if you have any kind of disability and are seeking employment. Whether your disability is physical, such as a mobility challenge or is not visible, such as a mental health condition or learning disability, you may be eligible for services.

Your Vocational Rehabilitation Counselor will support you during your journey by arranging services such as vocational counseling, assistive technology, and job-related training.

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For purposes of the Vocational Rehabilitation program, the Federal Vocational Rehabilitation grant pays 78.7 percent of the total costs of the program. In Federal fiscal year 2022, the Vocational Rehabilitation agency anticipates receiving \$287,666,847 in Federal Vocational Rehabilitation funds. Funds appropriated by the State pay 21.3 percent of the total costs (\$77,856,466) under the Vocational Rehabilitation program.

For purposes of the Supported Employment program, Federal funds paid 90 percent of the total costs. In Federal fiscal year 2022, the Vocational Rehabilitation agency received \$1,446,266 in Federal Supported Employment funds. State appropriated funds paid 10 percent (\$80,348) of the total costs under the Supported Employment program.
